Spring Clean - Up Street Sweeping

The 2021 Spring Clean-up will begin mid April and runs until July. Street sweeping is done throughout the week from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on residential streets, and in the evenings or overnight on major routes. You can find the street sweeping schedule at www.calgary.ca/sweep.

Watch for the street cleaning signs that will be placed around the community, indicating when your street is scheduled for sweeping and when the parking ban will be in effect. Any vehicle that has not been removed from the street during the times indicated on the sign is subject to ticketing. If street sweeping falls on garbage pickup day, place your garbage bins on the sidewalk or grass bouleavard next to the curb when sweeping is scheduled.



Dog Owners

Just a friendly reminder to all our Quarry Park dog owners that Quarry Park is not an off-leash area and dogs are required to be on-leash at all times. The Sue Higgins off-leash park is only a short walk north of Quarry Park across the Carburn Park pedestrian bridge. We also kindly ask that you always pick up after your dog and put your bags in the trash to help keep our beautiful community clean.





Did you know that we have a community garden? Located near the skating rink in Douglasdale, along Douglasdale Boulevard, the garden has been in operation for 10 years and welcomes families from the DouglasGlen, Quarry Park and Douglasdale communities. The garden offers small plots that are four by eight feet in dimension, in raised beds in a parklike setting to as many as 30 families. Members of the DouglasQuarry Community Association can rent a plot for \$30 per year. You do not need to have a green thumb to grow your own fresh, organic food, and more experienced gardeners are always happy to share tips and tricks that have worked for them.

Below is a list of activities that are curently available:

Supervised High Intensity Weight Floor

- Any use of cardio equipment or high intensity weight lifting; 1hr appointment; Supervised by YMCA staff

Low Intensity Weight Floor

- Any other weight floor activity such as light to moderate weight lifting, stretching, walking on the track; 1hr appointment

Supervised Lane Swimming

- 1 swimmer per lane; 1hr appointment; supervised by YMCA staff

Family Recreational Swimming

- Access to leisure pool for one household; up to 6 participants; 1hr appointment - Classes such as Yoga, Gentle Fit, Full Body Strength; must pre-register; schedule varies by day
