City of Calgary Branching Out Program

The City of Calgary's "Branching Out" program is back for 2022. Calgary's tree canopy coverage is currently at 8.25% - which includes trees planted on both public and private property. The City is working to grow and expand the tree canopy to 16% by providing a limited number of free trees to citizens. Registration for the program opens on May 16. Trees are available on a first come, first serve basis. When registering, you must agree to submit a photo and location of where the tree will be planted on your property to 311. Species that will be available for this year are:

- Siberian Larch
- Ussurian Pear
- Trembling Aspen
- Paper Birch
- Courageous Crab
- Ponderosa Pine

Spring Clean - Up Street Sweeping

The 2022 Spring Clean-up will begin mid April and runs until July. Street sweeping is done throughout the week from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on residential streets, and in the evenings or overnight on major routes. You can find the street sweeping schedule at www.calgary.ca/sweep.

Watch for the street cleaning signs that will be placed around the community, indicating when your street is scheduled for sweeping and when the parking ban will be in effect. Any vehicle that has not been removed from the street during the times indicated on the sign is subject to ticketing. If street sweeping falls on garbage pickup day, place your garbage bins on the sidewalk or grass boulevard next to the curb when sweeping is scheduled.

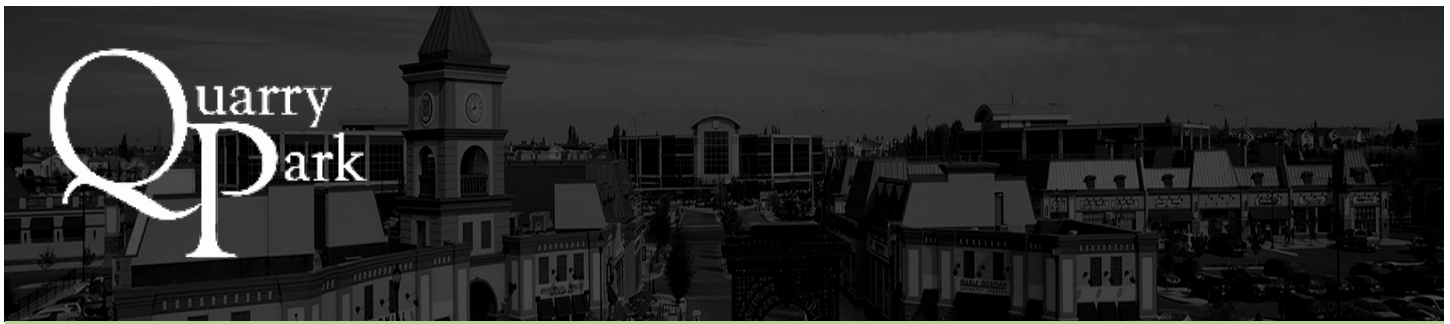

The Sue Higgins off-leash park is only a short walk north of Quarry Park across the Carburn Park pedestrian bridge. We also kindly ask that you always pick up after your dog and put your bags in the trash to help keep our beautiful community clean.





City of Calgary Picnic Sites

Did you know that Calgary has numerous parks throughout the City that have reservable picnic site areas? Starting May long weekend until Thanksgiving weekend, you can reserve a picnic area for your exclusive use starting at \$69. Picnic sites are booked on a first-come, first-served basis. All picnic sites are booked in 6 hour time slots: from 8:45 am – 2:45 pm and 3:15 pm – 9:15 pm, with a 30 minute buffer in between. 9:00am – 5:00pm Stat Holidays (beginning Good Friday, April 15 2022)

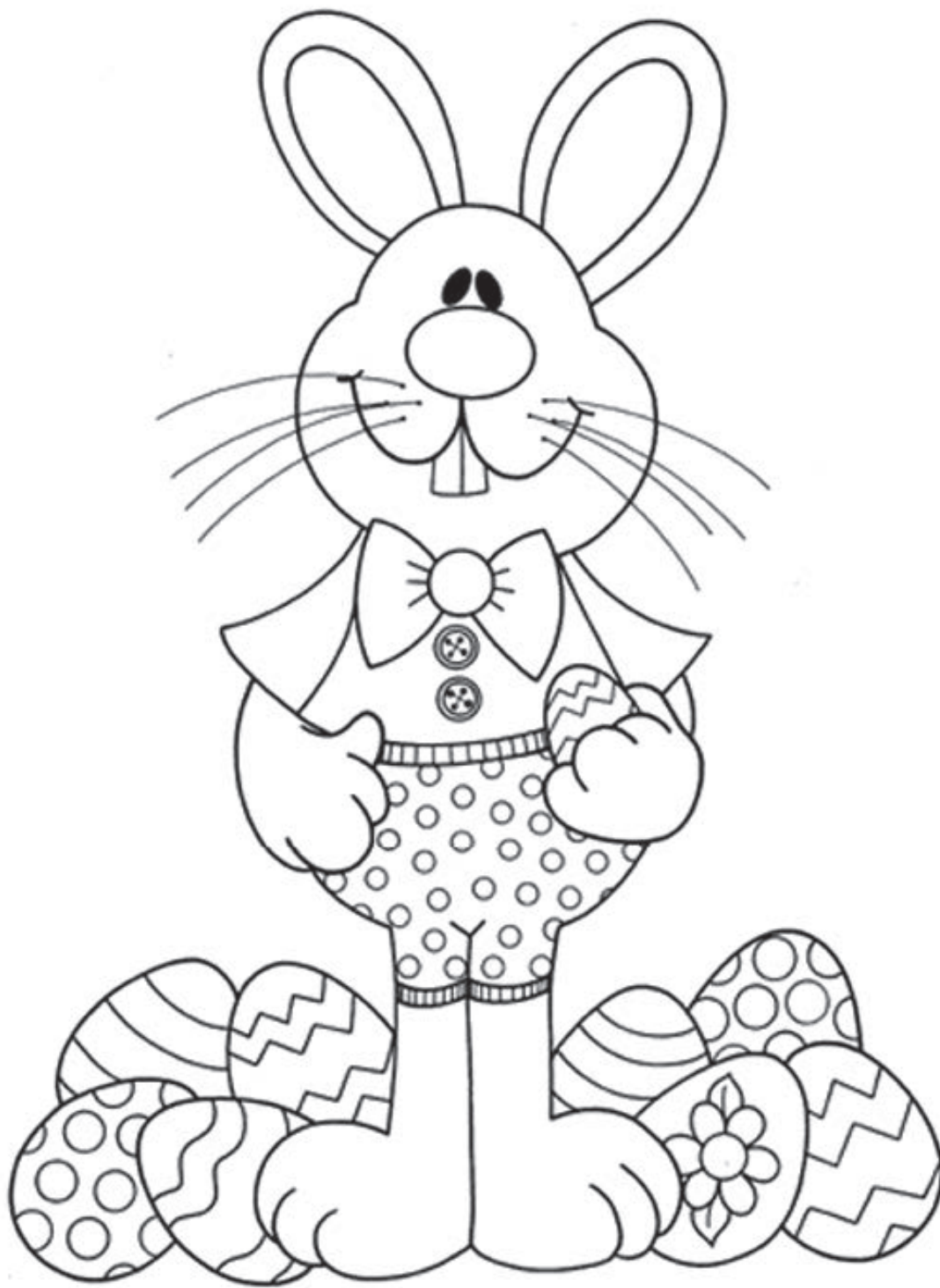

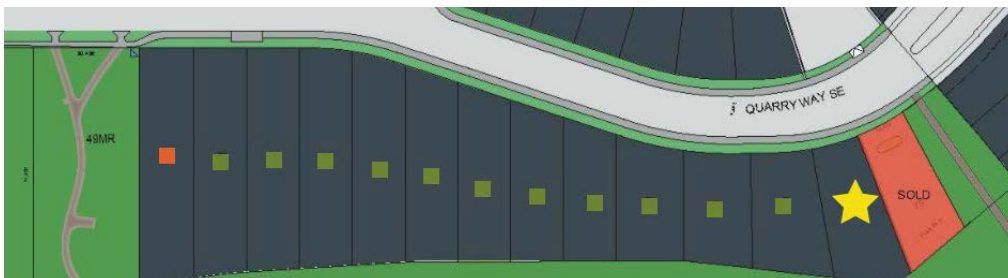
