## Spring Clean - Up Street Sweeping

The 2025 Spring Clean-up begins this month and runs until July. Street sweeping is done throughout the week from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on residential streets, and in the evenings or overnight on major routes. You can find the street sweeping schedule at [www.calgary.ca/sweep](http://www.calgary.ca/sweep).

Watch for the street cleaning signs that will be placed around the community, indicating when your street is scheduled for sweeping and when the parking ban will be in effect. Any vehicle that has not been removed from the street during the times indicated on the sign is subject to ticketing. If street sweeping falls on garbage pickup day, place your garbage bins on the sidewalk or grass boulevard next to the curb when sweeping is scheduled.

The City has launched a street sweeping alert service. Sign up for e-mail and/or text alerts and never miss another sweeping day again. You can register multiple addresses via The City's myID program. Visit <https://roadnotifications.calgary.ca> to receive your notifications.



## Did you know?



The City is adjusting the waste collection routes to ensure more efficient and reliable service. Be sure to check your schedule to find out if your blue, black, or green cart pickup day is changing and when your weekly green cart collection begins.

Free mulch is available at the East Calgary landfill for all residential homeowners. No appointment required. You can pick up mulch anytime the landfill is open.
